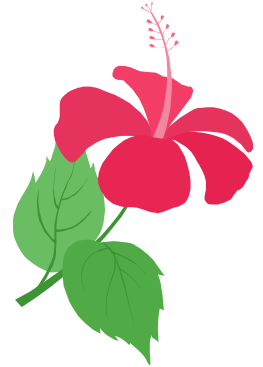

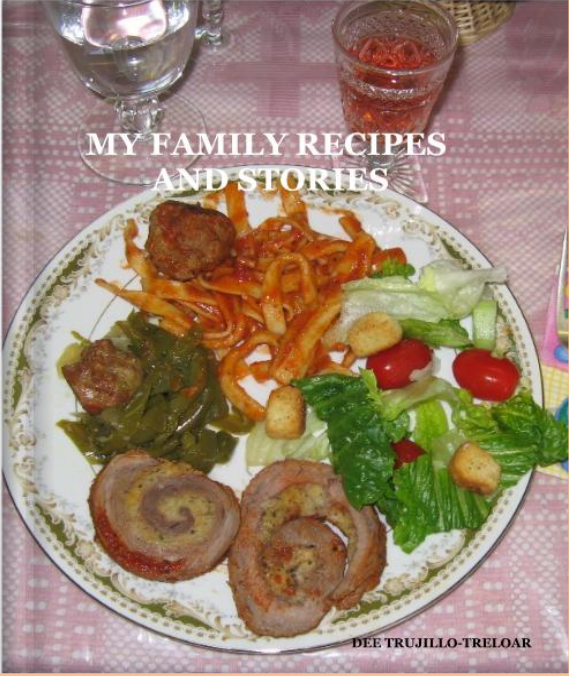

# RECIPES

This is a recipe from Dee's book of her family recipes

## Italian Cannoli

2 eggs well beaten    ½ cup sugar    ¼ cup butter or margarine  
¼ cup vegetable oil    ¼ teaspoon salt    1 teaspoon cinnamon  
1 tablespoon white vinegar    3 tablespoon water    1 ½ cup flour

Baked on Pizzelle Iron

Blending together eggs, sugar, butter and oil, then add the other ingredients.

Make as Pizzelle's, then roll hot cookie into a cylinder and secure with a toothpick and allow to cool. Fill with filling and sprinkle with powdered sugar.

## Cannoli Filling

2 cup (1 lb) ricotta cheese    1 cup powder sugar  
1 teaspoon vanilla    ½ cup chopped candied or Marciano cherries  
1 small can of drained pineapple    ¼ cup semi-sweet chocolate pieces

Blend cheese and sugar until smooth. Add remaining ingredients.

Some people like to add nuts. I like the nuts and don't like the chocolate pieces.

This was the way my mother and Grandma did these cookies.

By the time I started doing them, I was trying things a little different. I made them with Custard filling or I added one pint of heavy whipped Whip Cream to the regular recipe.

This made them Creamy, Tasty and Smooth!!!!!!

If you should have any left over, be sure to put them in the refrigerator.
